Dear Friends,

It is an honor to welcome you tonight as we celebrate the HSF Annual Dinner Event. The

Haitian Sports Foundation (HSF) has become a legitimized NGO (Non-Governmental Organization) and gained recognition for its financial rigor which has helped in changing the lives and mindset of the children it serves through sports, education and cultural activities.

In the past two years, HSF invested over \$80,000 in capital investment in addition to \$150,000 in operational activities which comprises of services ranging from individual scholarships and programs within its mission. As a 501c3, 100% of the funding is allocated to the mission of the organization.

In 2019, HSF accomplished two major milestones:

- Firstly, the construction of a basketball court, which was mainly funded by Basket Plus; a Canadian Girls Basketball Team, managed by Ms. Rose Ann Joly. It was built to develop the HSF kids and encourage interschool competition among the community, since basketball is relatively new to the children of Anse-à-Veau. Besides martial arts and soccer, this sport will teach young minds how to collaborate as a team as well as addressing differences in a peaceful manner.

The HSF Executive Board and I wish to express our sincere gratitude to Basket Plus and the athletes of the University of Ottawa, Canada, who traveled to Haiti, against all odds, to inaugurate the basketball court and make this project a reality. The athletes are to be commended for their selfless contribution to the children of Haiti.

We also recognize **Coalition for the Renewal of Anse-à-Veau (CORA)**, "l' Eglise de Ste Anne d'Anse-à-Veau" and the "Fédération Nationale de Basketball d'Haiti" for their undivided support and collaboration.

- Secondly, on May 3, 2019 HSF opened a medical clinic providing basic preventive care to the Nippes community. The medical staff is composed of a doctor and two nurses who serviced 87 patients including infants and elderly on the very first day. Patients were treated for fever, blood pressure, poor eyesight, diabetes, burns, and other ailments. It is our goal to increase the number of field visits from once to twice per month. Due to the medical service we are providing, there has been a surge in the number of patients from 87 in May to 107 in August.

A special thanks to the HSF Board Members for their continued support of our mission. I am extremely grateful for what you have done and continue to do in making the HSF a trusted and successful organization. As a result, we earned the Platinum Seal of Competency from Guide Star.

Finally, a sincere thanks to all who have contributed in one form or another in assisting HSF achieve its mission and make its goals a reality.

May the Great Architect of the Universe continue to bless you and continue to allow us the opportunity to share our God giving talents together as ONE as we work to make Haiti a better place for its citizen.


